

POPI POPI App

Purpose

In terms of the Protection of Personal Information Act (POPI) students have the choice to indicate whether they would like to have their personal information (e.g. contact details, examination results, etc) dealt with as private by the NWU.

Should they indicate that they want the information to be considered as private personal information, the NWU may not share this information with external persons (e.g. parents, guardians, bursary holders, etc) and/or organisations.

The purpose of the **POPI App** is to indicate if a person's information is private or not.

Steps

1. Sign into the **POPI App**.
2. Provide the person's university number and see if their information is private (Yes) or not (No).
3. Click on the "Clear" button for another search.
